

ANGLING GUERNSEY

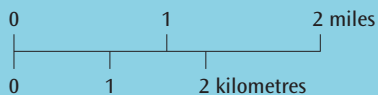

Good luck everybody - and happy fishing.

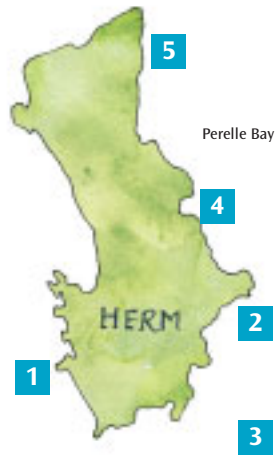
The Top Ten places to fish

10. Anywhere in Guernsey is good for fishing - let us know if you discover any hot spots!



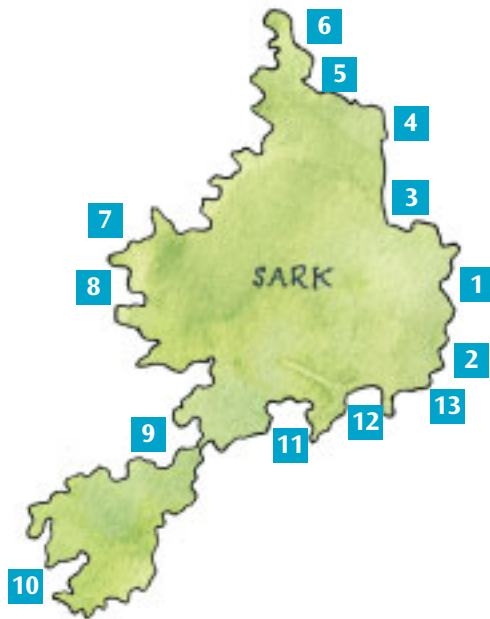
