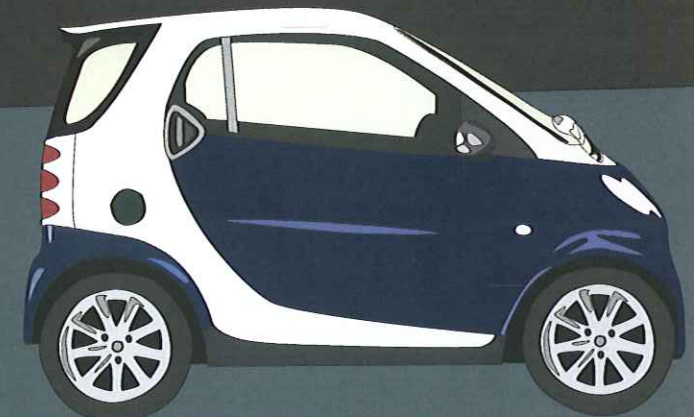

Small Spaces for Small Cars in St. Peter Port

What is Small Car Parking?

As part of the Road Transport Strategy, the Environment Department has introduced a small car parking scheme that provides dedicated preferentially located parking spaces for small cars in the centre of St Peter Port. The Department wishes to encourage the use of smaller vehicles in the Island as they can bring environmental benefits and are better suited to our narrow roads.

How does the scheme work and which type of cars can park there in St. Peter Port?

There are three dedicated small car parking zones in existing car parks. The small car parking spaces in all three zones measure 2.1 m by 3.6 m for parallel parking and 2.33 m by 3.6 m for right angled parking. Drivers must park within the marked bays and not extend into the manoeuvring area or buffer zone. *If the overall length of your car does not exceed 3.6 m, then you are entitled to park there.* There is a range of vehicles that should fit within these spaces. Typical examples are given overleaf.

Where is the parking located?

The scheme has been established at the **Careening Hard Arm on the Crown Pier** since 2005. Following its success, the Environment Department has now extended the scheme to cover the south east corner of the **Albert Pier** (opposite the fishermen's quay), and on the **North Beach Car Park** along the northern edge of the 10 hour parking zone, where spaces are marked at right angles to the wall. There are 43 small car parking spaces on the Careening Hard Arm, 16 on the Albert Pier and 36 on the North Beach. Each zone can be identified by the "Small Car Parking" signs and road markings.

Small Car Parking Zone	Maximum Permitted Stay
Albert Pier	2 hour disc parking
Careening Hard Arm	10 hour disc parking
North Beach	10 hour disc parking

How will the scheme be enforced?

Each parking space will be marked out individually in accordance with the above dimensions. It is an offence to park "in a manner contrary to that indicated by a parking sign or a white line marked in the road" and, therefore, anyone parking a car too large for the space would be committing an offence and may be reported or issued with a Fixed Penalty Ticket.
